What do co-operative governance practices look like? Theory predicts they should be different from investor-owned firms but are they? Using data gathered from the second (2022) wave of the Canadian Co-operative Governance Survey, Marc-André Pigeon, Director and Strategic Research Fellow at the Canadian Centre for the Study of Co-operatives (CCSC), and Stan Yu, CCSC Research and Communications Coordinator, will share some comparative results from their 2023 study, **Report from the Boardroom** (to be released September 27, 2023), providing a snapshot on key co-operative governance topics such as board diversity, succession planning, and democratic decision-making.
